I understand that in performing today's procedure(s) my pet will receive sedation or general anesthesia. I understand that anesthetic and surgical procedures may involve the risk of complications. While we take every precaution possible to avoid complications: no guarantee can be expressed or implied.

- **Monitoring** - All patients at Adobe Animal Hospital are monitored during anesthetic procedures. This includes electrocardiography (EKG), pulse oximetry, blood pressure, and capnography. In addition to the monitoring equipment: all surgeries are manually monitored by the doctor or a dedicated veterinary technician anesthetist during the procedure.
- **Intravenous catheterization** - For most surgical procedures, an intravenous catheter is placed to provide an easy route to administer medications and fluids which allows us to maintain blood pressure and support kidney function during the procedure.

CPR - In the unlikely event of an emergency; your pet may require cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). This can include cardiac compressions, positive pressure respiration, emergency medications, or other interventions. If I request such emergency procedures, I agree to be held responsible for veterinary services provided to my pet while staff members pursue treatment and try to reach me for further directions. Regardless of my pet's recovery or survival: I agree to pay CPR fees in addition to other fees already identified by the practice and agreed upon by me.
